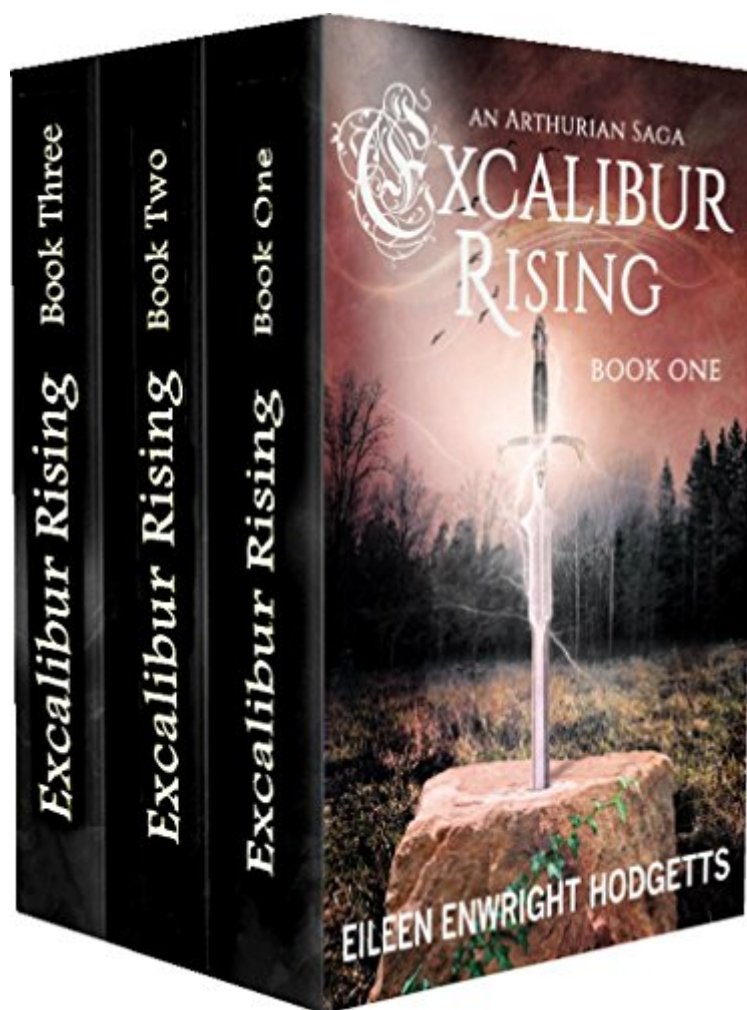


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Excalibur Rising Books One Two And Three: An Arthurian Saga

I was so relieved to see a fourth book is coming out soon. Five stars for the story, for the characters, the originality, but minus one star for poor proofreading. So many errors it was annoying, even though they are minor. The fact that they are minor bothered me because they are easily spotted, and should have been fixed. Brava on a great series!

This set of books 1, 2 and 3 are of a romantic quality of hopes and action combined with ancient magic and just enough modern technology to make the future from the past and to the past possible the journey that you are taken on if you have ever studied King Arthur and the Knights of the round table even as a child you will relive your dreams of dragons castles and battles for fame honor and glory but will find to your dismay that all dreams are not as clean and honorable as you wish they were. I loved the first book and the second was OK. The third was a huge disappointment. I'm not sure I will bother with Book 4. In Book 2 Hodgetts finds a way to solve Arthur's greatest problem, that of a successor, but her solution feels so trite. I just couldn't get past that. The main problem with Book 3 is that the same people who rushed to one world are now rushing to get back to the other.
