

This book is however an excellent resource and will help to point the user in the right directions. Topics include but aren't limited to: Plant propagation (by seeds, splitting bulbs, hard and softwood cuttings, etc.), introduction to greenhousing, vegetable gardening, certain fruits i.e. strawberries, raspberries, and houseplants.
