


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The North And South Pole? : K12 Life Science Series: Arctic Exploration And Antarctica Books (Children's Explore Polar Regions Books)

This is reserved for the worst of the worst in our house. My children learn to read by the time they are four years old so this was a breeze for them. The 3 year old was not much interested in pictures of ice and snow. The older kids have read and seen documentaries on a lot of this material so they were not impressed. If your kids are not at all familiar with these areas or geography in general there may be something useful here for them. Some of the pictures were really nice. One that did not make sense was one supposedly taken at the north pole where there is no land, only ice. There is a road in a wooded area with a mail box. The last time I studied botany I don't remember any trees that grow in ice. Either they are wrong about there being no land, or wrong about where the picture was taken or something! I received this book free in exchange for my honest review.

This is an excellent ebook for kids! As a teacher of elementary students, I would love to incorporate this ebook into a small group activity where I present a main idea or topic to the whole class and then they break up in small groups and discover more material on their own. My mind was continuously racing as I read through this book thinking of different projects I could make on this topic. It is the perfect age group to let them use a kindle to explore and what a better way to do so than with this ebook!
