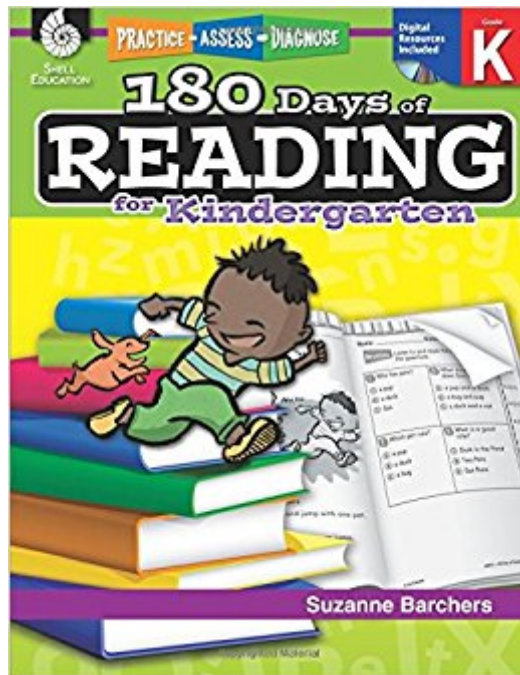

I am not thrilled with the book 180 days of Reading for Kindergarten. We didn't start this book until half way through the kindergarten year. If we had started at the beginning of the year, it would have been way too hard. It is discouraging for a beginning student. I think this would be better suited for children at the end of their kindergarten year or early first grade year.

Using this book with my 5.5 YO son. We do a full weeks lesson in one sitting and he is learning so much. Nice I have access to teacher products for reasonable prices to help prep him for Kindergarten.

My daughter LOVED this. She was in Pre-K4 and finished this book in a little over 2 months. This is the best book we have used for her. I reccomend doing 5 pages per day as a workflow. On each page you learn words that make up a story at the end. My daughter went from knowing about 50 sight words to reading "Green Eggs and Ham" independently in a matter of 4 weeks.
