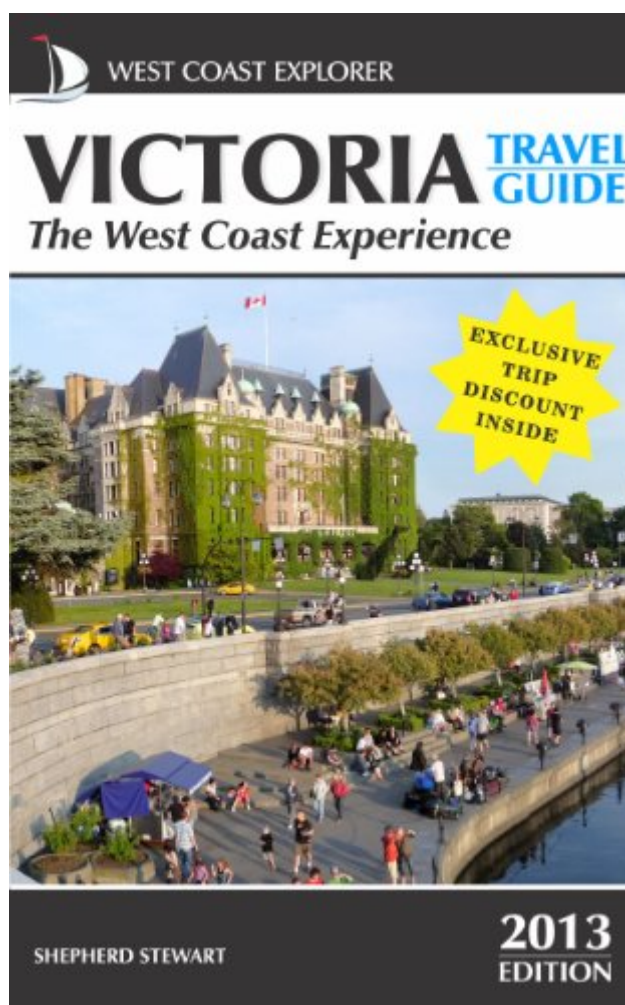

There are a few maps, ferry schedules and hints for getting around in Victoria. there is Hotel and restaurant information of course along with descriptions of art galleries and museums. There is some historical and geological coverage too. Some telephone numbers and weather charts as well. The book is easy to use and finding things is a breeze.
