

I'm not one to write a review but this book goes in-depth on everything you need to know about the Canon 70D. When you need to go back and look up a topic this book outlines subjects clearly and right to the point. I highly recommend this book to learn your 70D in and out.

I'm not stupid, I could get somethin from this book, and I did... but not a lot. If you've got a basic understanding of manual mode just go look up what some setting mean and how to do some things, your time will be better spent.

I've been taking photographs for 45 years, but have always thought I could learn more about the craft, so I've amassed quite a library on the subject of photography. Julie Adair King's 'Canon EOS 70D for Dummies' is the latest addition as a guide to getting the most out of my newest DSLR. A good portion of the books addresses basic photography concepts (something I like to review on almost a weekly basis), but the author does a fine job of relating each of these concepts to the 70D. Like all of the other Dummies, and Idiots publications this book has hints, tips, and cautions in the margins which sometimes take the reader of the immediate track. Also, like many books the narrative about a particular photo illustration (mostly about menu options) is not always found on the same page as the illustration. However, that's a very minor complaint. King obviously knows her DSLRs, and does a very good job of walking the 70D owner through the camera's capabilities, and provides enough experienced based information to make the book useful not only to the novice, but to the enthusiast as well.

This guide was very helpful. It gives me comfort that I'm actually taking advantage of all the features my camera comes with.

I am a visual learner and do not like technical anything. I've been taking photos for many years and after purchasing my new camera decided to finally learn the techincal components so I could shoot on more than just the auto setting. This book has been absolutely amazing and very helpful. I would definitely recommend!
