

This is the latest edition of a well written book that covers all topics related to anorectal diseases in an exhaustive manner. The text is well supported with images and has been updated to reflect the latest in the management of these common yet hard to treat diseases. While my review is titled 'excellent book for specialists in anorectal diseases', and is a must have in the personal collection for every gastroenterologist, colorectal surgeon, urogynecologist, this is also well suited as a

reference text for gynecologists, surgeons as well as primary care physicians who are the first stop for many of these conditions, to make an accurate diagnosis and refer to the right specialist if required. I am myself a gastroenterologist with an interest in anorectal diseases and find my knowledge considerably improved after reading this book.

Dr. Ehrenpreis has written an excellent manual with brief explanations of most anal and rectal diseases. Supplemented by color photos and clear drawings it gives brief descriptions of diseases, clinical procedures, treatments, and other useful information. While not intended for laypersons, the writing is clear enough that laypersons can understand these conditions. Most family doctors should have a copy of this manual if for no other reason than to provide information to their patients on diseases and diagnostic procedures they might need! It would also make an excellent addition to most libraries which often lack good information on these conditions. I highly recommend it!
