Scott Ward has written a trio of excellent "what if" histories of WW2. Many such alternate histories rest on preposterous assumptions or faulty research, but not Scott Ward's books. Despite a few, very minor, technical mistakes, most readers familiar with WW2 history should find these books both enjoyable and plausible.

Outstanding speculative history, with great detail as well as interesting and believable fictional characters. I cannot wait for further works.

The seizure of Malta is perhaps the only realistic option that the Germans had to win or prolong WW II that has not been thoroughly and thoughtfully pursued.
