

Justin was a Rhodes Scholar and received a doctorate in English from Oxford University after which he became a research fellow at the University of Cape Town, where he now teaches part-time. His articles and photographs have appeared internationally in a number of publications and on a wide range of topics, while his short stories and poems have been published in various anthologies. He is a two-time Mondi journalism award winner. His recent books include *The Marginal Safari* (Umuzi, 2010), *Whoever Fears the Sea* (Umuzi, 2014) and *The Impossible Five* (Tafelberg, 2015). He was long-listed for the 2011 Alan Paton Award for non-fiction,
