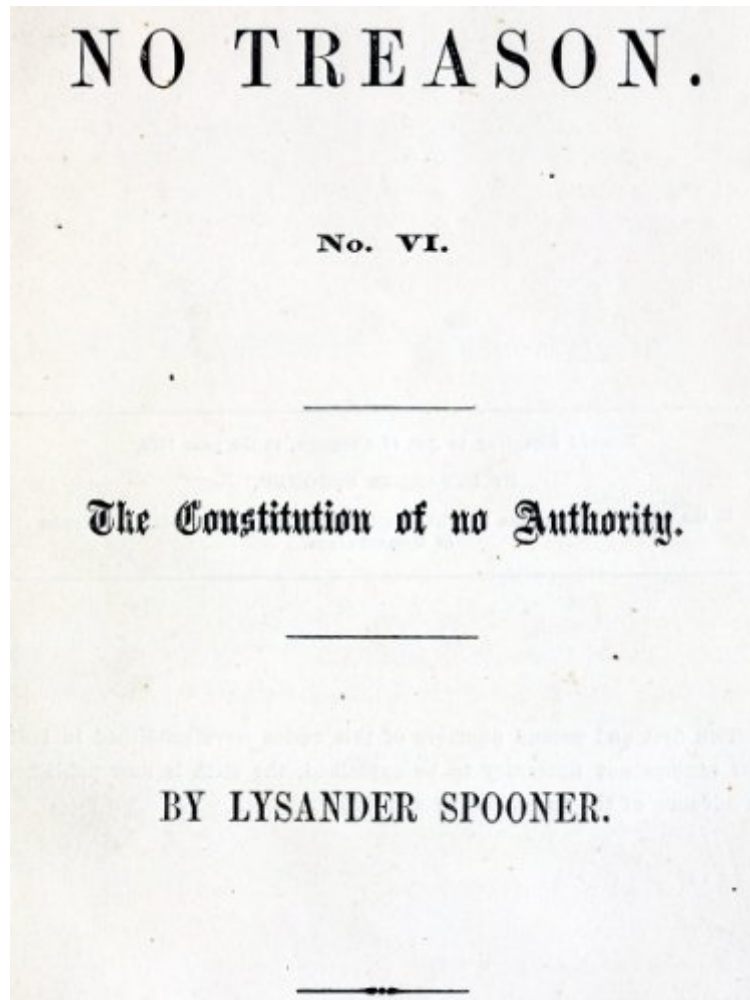


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No Treason: The Constitution Of No Authority (Complete Series)

How can all the people of the United States be bound to a government when (at the time) only a small number of adult white males with property were allowed to vote? On the work itself: Spooner writes his treatise authoritatively and rationally. It's full of quotable passages but is a brief read. The structure and language can get repetitive, as the work is one large, organized argument with verbatim points.
