

This book was generally well written, logically organized, and easy to understand. Kindle formatting was fine, and I noted only a few typos or grammar problems.

Loved it. He's unbiased and gets really detailed. He covers all aspects of buying a house and even talks about obscure types of properties like co-ops (which I happen to live in). My biggest takeaway is that he shows you how to NOT make mistakes. For most people, buying a house is the biggest financial transaction they'll ever make. Alex shows you the common pitfalls and how to avoid them. It's extremely helpful, especially given the housing crisis and subsequent economic collapse we saw back in 2008.

I've been in and around the real estate industry in many different ways for over a decade now and I've never seen anyone put together a more useful resource for people looking to make the right decision that truly serves them with a real estate transaction.
