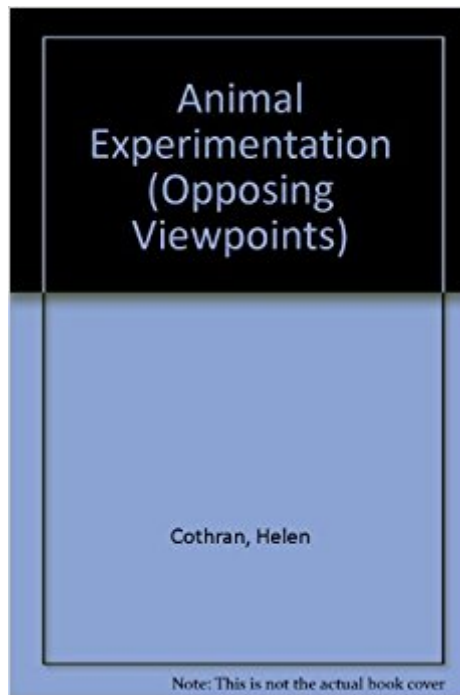

attitudes about animal experimentation set the stage for the sometimes heated, sometimes heartfelt essays in this entry in the Opposing Viewpoints series. The first section argues the overall question of animal rights and the notion of animal rights activists as terrorists. The next two sections deal with animal experimentation (Is it vital? Is it ethical?), with a good deal of space devoted to the way animal experiments are conducted, particularly those using nonhuman primates, dogs, and rodents. The final section considers relatively new issues: genetic engineering, cloning, animal donors for human transplants. It's a well-balanced anthology of opinions from professors, clergy, doctors, and animal rights activists, with an excellent assortment of further resources to help students and others research the issues.
