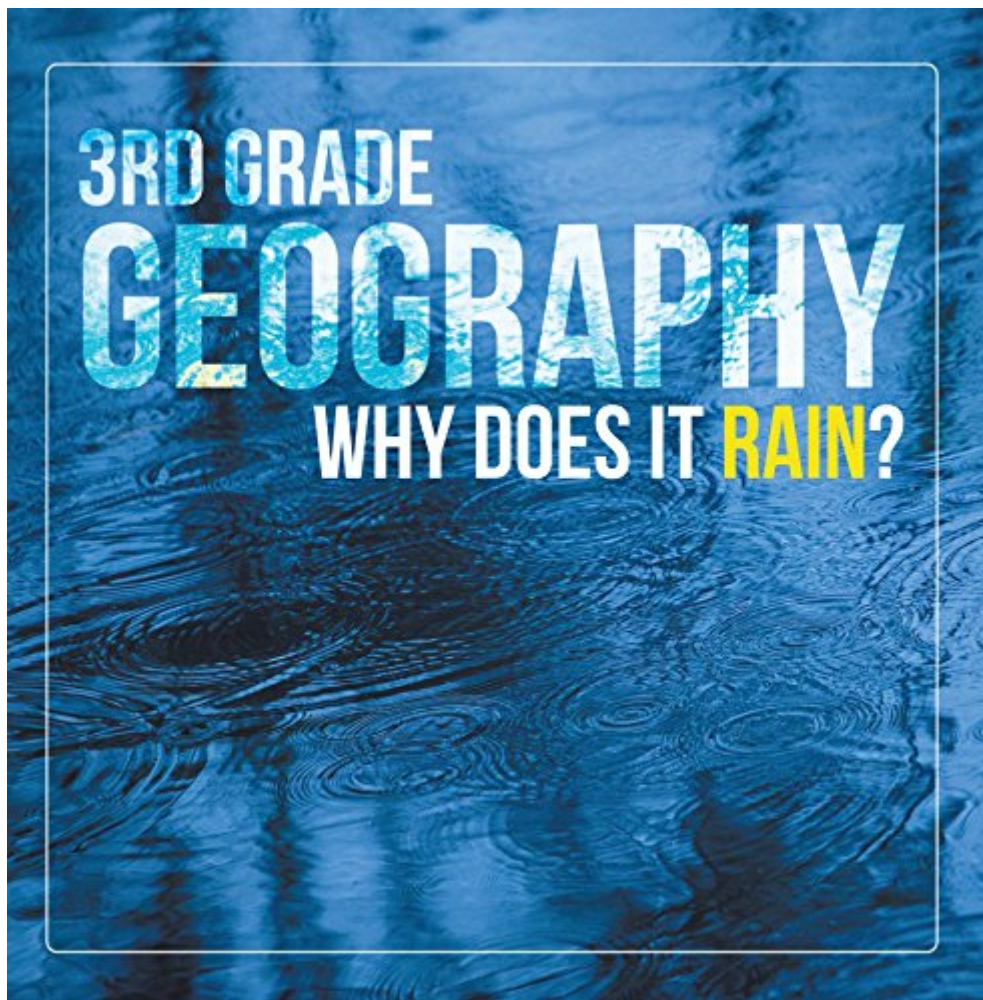

These books are filled with exceptional photographs and content geared towards capturing a 3rd grader's attention span. Easy and fun to read! These books are excellent for use in the classroom or at home. Excellent tool to help children not only learn about geography, but it helps to encourage them to read as well. This colorful short book provides children with a brief overview on what rain is and where it comes from. Beautiful, detailed, colored photos along with age appropriate descriptions and fun facts about how the air and water vapor can affect the humidity in the summer, when rain can occur, the importance of clouds and what forms of water can fall from the sky can all be found in this book. These books are great conversation starters for children. The beautiful pictures open up a dialogue for children to express what they see and what they understand by looking at the photographs. I have recently had the opportunity to review a large number of the Baby Professor Books in exchange for providing honest reviews of their products. I am a mother and a school administrator and I am always in search of books that can be read to students to give enrichment to the topics

and subjects they are currently learning. I like to make sure that our teachers pull students in and have them participate in their own learning instead of just teaching AT them. These books definitely assist in that mission. I have used the science books, the geography books and the history books to enrich our students' lessons. Each book lightly touches a topic and leaves much room for discussion and expansion by the teachers and students. In the rain and precipitation book, we talk about how clouds form, the different types of precipitation and the implications it can have on animal and plant life if it is too much or too little. Baby Professor books always have beautiful and intricate photography. Typically, we zoom in on the photos and describe the scenery or the mechanism of whatever is happening. If there is an animal, we describe its features and habitat, things we knew about the animal, things we learned from the book, and questions we still have about it. For geography books, we talk about the countries, regions, or landmarks and whether or not we have been to or seen a similar place, similar people or similar landmarks. In the rain and precipitation book, we talk about the density of the clouds, the formation of lightning and we just overall admire the beauty of the photography in this book. Students really get involved in their education and are always eager to share their own experiences to enrich discussion with Baby Professor Books.
